After an in-depth discussion, the music award juries JUN Hyosung and HWANG Hyunsung decided that the award should go to My Sunny Maad. We decided that the quality of the music can't be the sole aspect of the rankings in this category. Instead, we looked for the harmony of the music with the video in conveying the story. The music of My Sunny Maad has enough auditory intensity, but it stays in place not being too excessive, and puts weight on the story of the film. It was impressive that the refreshing wind instrument of the music led the melody on the native base reminiscent of the Middle East culture, harmonized the center without erasing the color of tradition, and helped the film develop its natural scenes. Also, even when the music stopped, they arranged various sounds in the narrative, such as the sound of tableware hitting, children's laughter, and market sounds, all made a rhythmical effect. It was amazing as they were all combined and sounded as if listening to a single song. In the more educational scenes where women dream of freedom, they played a pop-style music showing their unlimited musical production, which further shone the meaning of the film that talks about women's freedom and growth. Other candidates all showed their own atmosphere and charmed on different stages. Therefore, we'd like to emphasize again that this review does not mean any superiority or inferiority in their musical performances, but is the result of paying attention to video music of the 'Animation' genre.
